Who you are:

The C&D Coordinator will hold a Community Coaching Accreditation or equivalent with a good understanding of modern coaching principles to ensure support for junior and senior coaches whilst promoting a high standard of coaching within the club.

Able to hold and maintain a valid working with Children's Blue Card

Responsible to:

The C&D Coordinator is responsible to the management committee and will directly report to the Vice President.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- In conjunction with Rugby League Brisbane, ensure all club coaches hold appropriate and up to date accreditations
- Lead and support coaches in working together to cultivate an environment that fosters a safe, fun and inclusive experience for all players
- Create training structures to be delivered by coaches for all ages that considers the physical and socio-emotional requirements of player development
- Develop a program to introduce new players from the community
- Liaise with coaches to support the implementation of training structures, offering feedback and guidance
- Attend professional development opportunities to assist in upskilling and training of club coaches
- Work with the management committee to ensure there is enough coaches for the club's requirements
- Ensure all teams have adequate space to train effectively and safely on training nights
- Re-establish an intraclub development squad for international league junior players
- Be available to assist with games if necessary
- Consistently emphasise the club's support of the NRL Code of Conduct and support coaches to abide by the club Constitution and Bylaws
- Assist in investigation of breaches in Code of Conduct incidents if required
